Hello everyone,

As expected, Caritas International sent us to Ukraine ten days ago to reinforce the team of volunteers already there.

The situation at the Polish border where we have been working for four months has changed since now there are as many people fleeing Ukraine as people returning to their country.

People who flee their country to go to the four corners of Europe have resources. But there are also a large number of poor people arriving from eastern Ukraine who cannot cross the border. So, they crowd into refugee camps in the west of the country, particularly in the cities of Lviv and Kyiv.

The first days we stayed in Lviv to reinforce the teams of volunteers. Then on Sunday June 26 we took the road to Kyiv.

We work a lot on the outskirts of the capital, in disaster-stricken neighborhoods where the refugees from the east of the country to whom we provide assistance are parked:

• In the morning from the international Caritas center, we distribute food and hygiene products, and we provide medical assistance.



• In the afternoon we leave to distribute food and all that is necessary in the affected villages of the periphery.



Many of you again ask me how to help us. Your donations are welcome to, initially, carry out the project to fit out a kitchen in a refugee centre.

Three other projects will be presented to you shortly. One in a medical center, and two others west of Kyiv.

Here are some pictures of our team and our mission with refugees.

Very very present in our hearts we really thank you.

Let us unite our prayers so that this dirty war ends as soon as possible.
